


Located right on the edge of the iconic Kilimanjaro Mountain, our boutique farm lodge is an ideal retreat for discerning travellers wanting a relaxed start or finish to their Tanzania safari and Kilimanjaro Trek, as well as a hub for immersive cultural excursions and unique coffee experience.

Lie of the Land

Our lodge is situated within 236 hectares on our organic coffee plantation at an altitude of 1400m above sea level, the two perennial rivers - Kyarongo and Ngomberi form the Eastern and Western boundary. To the north our farm extends to 1600amsl where fertile slopes give the rise to the lush Mount Kilimanjaro's montane forest. To the south we are bordering with the community of the Chagga people - the indigenous people of Kilimanjaro region.

There are several springs, waterfalls, river valleys and forest as well as a river conservation area - all yours to explore.

SPA

Our tropical spa is a sanctuary of relaxation and designed to enhance your wellness journey. It features an outdoor plunge pool and healing bath. Safety

There is no objective wildlife-related risk in the property, but since the lodge is located on a working farm, guests must be accompanied by local staff when walking outside of the lodge.

Sustainability

We are taking great care of the wellbeing of our neighboring community by creating employment, but also creating environmental and health promoting projects.

Our milestones to date:

- 23 Water Projects, supplying 2837 households with water
- High efficiency cooking stoves for 1278 Households to avoid health hazards and reduce deforestation.
- 42 Micro Biogas plant have been built.
- A dispensary has been built and handed over fully furnished to the Government. It is to date active and the only dispensary in our Village.
- We have set up 13 Groups for the support of Coffee Growers in our area. They have received each a small processing unit, and we are connecting them to the market.
- We planted 15000 Trees on our farm and the neighboring areas in effort to reverse the impact of deforestation.
- We have installed 2300 Micro Solar grids, supplying 2300 households with each 4 light bulbs and a Telephone charger.
- We have built sanitary facilities for 4 Primary schools and one Secondary school as well as built teachers offices and extensively repaired classrooms in one school.





Weather & Seasons

We are located on the edge of Kilimanjaro's rainforest, Summer is from September to March, and winter is from June to mid-August. The Lodge is closed in April and May due to the long rain season.

Accessibility

1hr 30 from Kilimanjaro International Airport 30-minutes' drive from Moshi town. 10-minute drive from Mount Kilimanjaro's Mweka gate.
